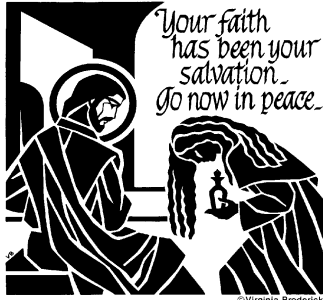

11th Sunday in Ordinary Time, June 13, 2010 by Father Greg Friedman, O.F.M

Mary Magdalene is one of the New Testament's most interesting characters—as well as someone whose reputation has been tainted by mistaken identity. Today's Gospel story is a good place to begin correcting that misinformation. From Luke's Gospel, we hear a story of a dramatic banquet at a Pharisee's house. There, a woman of sinful reputation enters and performs the gesture of bathing Jesus' feet with her tears, wiping them with her hair and anointing them with ointment. When the host is scandalized, Jesus uses the incident to remark about the woman's great love, and then goes on to forgive her. Later in the same Gospel passage, we hear that as Jesus journeys about preaching Good News, his company included some **"women who had been cured of evil spirits and infirmities," including "Mary, called Magdalene, from whom seven demons had gone out."** It's clear from the text that the two women in the story are different individuals. Mary Magdalene is portrayed in today's account as a follower of Christ—one who was in his company of believers, and who—in John's resurrection story—was an eyewitness to Jesus risen, and a messenger of that wonderful Good News to the apostles. Mary's role is one of Christian service and witness—a role we can do well to imitate.

The Pastor's Message

June 13, 2010

To begin with a word of special thanks to all who made our Archbishop's visit to Sacred Heart Church a truly memorable event. Thank you and congratulations to the three young people who received the Sacrament of Confirmation; and thanks to their parents and sponsors and family. A special note of thanks go to those who helped to prepare the young people for this important step in the life of Faith; thank you to the Catholic Women's League and the Knights of Columbus and the choir for their part in the ceremony, and not to forget the ladies who had prepared a lovely display of refreshments at the Parish Center . All in all a day in the parish to remember.

And secondly, as always I am preparing this message on Wednesday and this afternoon I am joining all my fellow priests and together with the Archbishop we will in our Diocese officially conclude and close the Year of the Priests. It has been a good year with much activity and many a prayer for all the priests in our parishes and those who are retired. We thank our Holy Father Benedict XVI for having been the inspiration for this special year. The year was promulgated last year on the Feast of the Sacred Heart and will officially end everywhere this Friday, June 11. As we again remember the Sacred Heart of Jesus; the special attention was asked for "Good Shepherds according to the Heart of Jesus". The Saint who was and continues to be a patron saint of pastors and all priests is the Holy Cure of Ars, Saint Jean Marie Vianney whose feast is celebrated annually on August 4th.

We thank our own Archbishop and so many people and groups from around the Diocese who have contributed to this special year by prayers, luncheons and events **"in appreciation for our priests"**. Personally I was very happy that it was in this same year that I celebrated my Golden Anniversary, together with others; and we also recalled and were saddened by the death of three faithful priests who died in this year and were specially blessed and remembered at their funeral Masses: **Fathers Terry Boyle, Bernie O'Neill and Jim Esper.** At the same time we know that this has been a difficult year in our church with great stress on the priesthood because of the many scandals we have heard about. A big thank you to all people for their solid support.

And although this special year may have come to an end, it was in a sense only an incentive to continue to pray for our priests and support them in many practical ways on a daily and weekly basis. Our Archbishop has spoken several times of a **"five year look ahead"**. This means that while all grow older, some may retire, there might be sickness or a death, and how many new priests will we have for the parishes? There are now 5 seminarians, one of whom was ordained to the Diaconate last week on his way to priestly ordination some time next year.

In conclusion to all people who have participated in the prayers and activities of this Year of the Priests, and all this with a fervent encouragement to continue your prayerful and practical support
